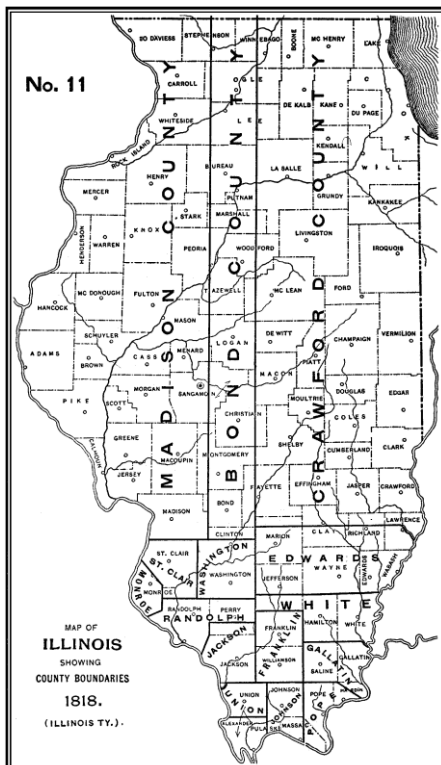

The 1818 census makes up the bulk of this work, listing over 4,000 heads of families. The number of free white males over twenty-one, all other white inhabitants, free persons of color, and servants or slaves is shown for each household. Data that has survived from the 1810 census is given in full with 1,310 heads of families, including information on their households. In all, this work includes 27,000 inhabitants of the Illinois Territory.

This resource contains notes comparing all discrepancies between names in the 1818 territorial, the 1820 state, and the 1820 federal censuses. The arrangement of the text is by counties, and there are 11,547 heads of families listed, representing over 50,000 individuals.
